Get to town as early as possible to enjoy Thursday doubles at Cactus Flats DGC (4pm - featuring Sunday's tournament layout), Friday doubles at Deer Canyon (4pm – featuring Saturday's tournament layout), early tourney registration at Deer Canyon doubles as well as Friday campout on the campground surrounded by the course. Double the fun by arriving in time for early-bird camping Friday night and enjoying the players party/campout on Saturday night! Ring of Fire and putting contest on Saturday...long-drive competition and raffle on Sunday (raffle held at awards banquet at Porky's Pit BBQ after 4th round).
